SUSTAINABILITY

Marmoleum is composed of up to 98% natural raw materials such as linseed oil, wood flour, limestone, rosin and jute and is PVC free. Marmoleum is unique as it has CO2 uptake in the product itself. The photosynthesis of the biobased materials used in Marmoleum provides CO2 uptake that exceeds the CO2 emissions caused by transportation and production processing. Therefore, Marmoleum is climate positive (or carbon negative) from cradle to gate, without offsetting. It's also recyclable, further reducing its environmental impact.

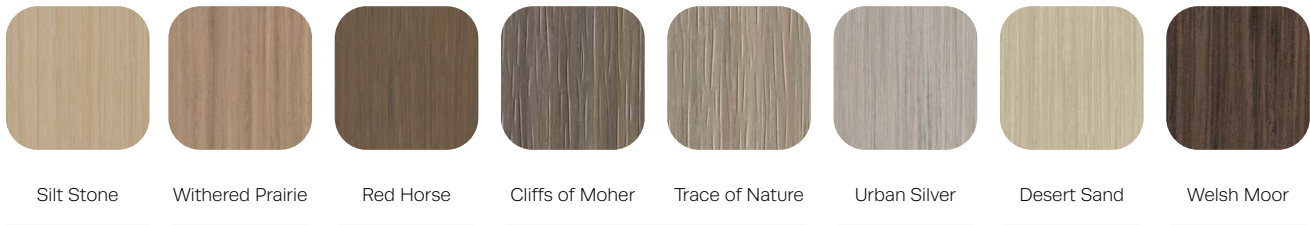

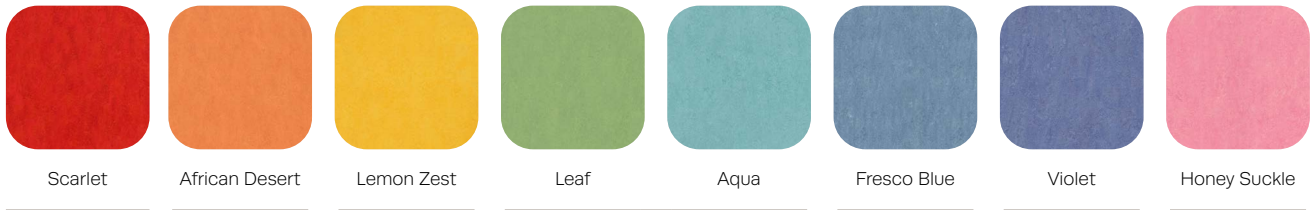

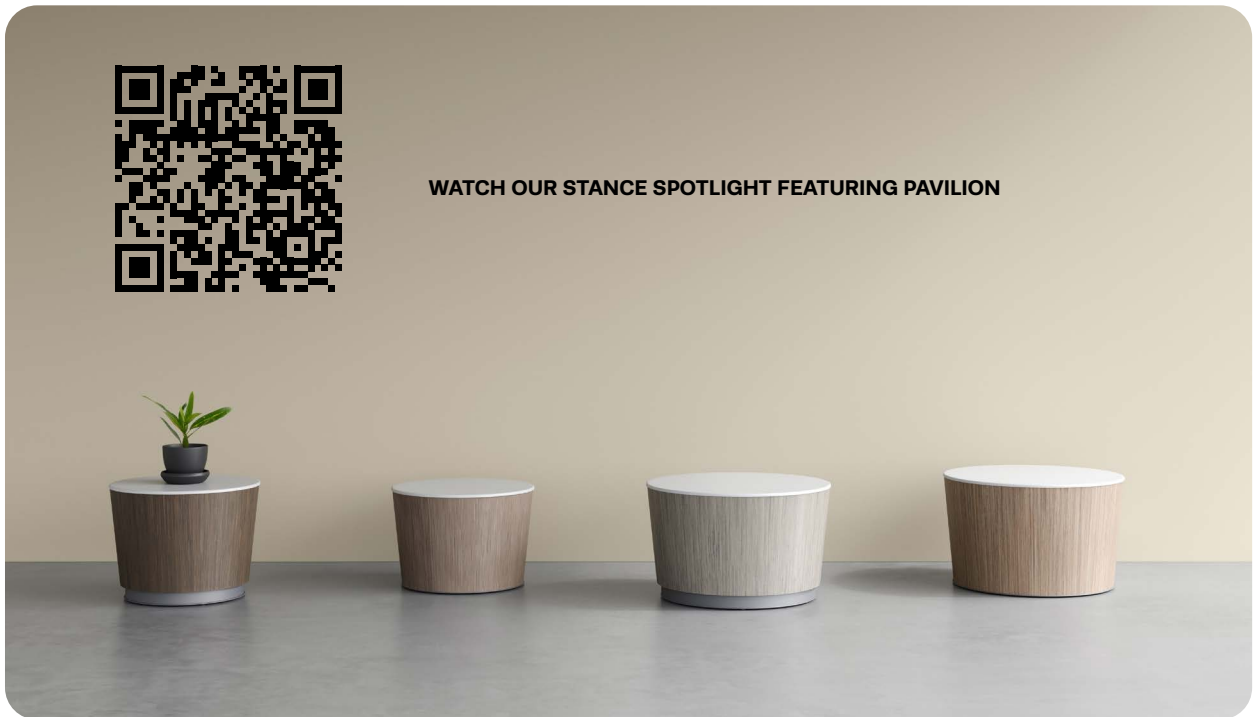
